- the wars of the Crusades were fought to free the Holy Land from the Muslims
- most Crusades failed, but they had many important results for the rest of Europe

 religious wars between Christians and Muslims for control of the Holy Land

## **Council of Clermont**

 meeting in France in 1095 to organize the first Holy War to control the Holy Land

### **Paladin**

holy knight bound by chivalry and goodness

# Motives for Convincing People to Go

- for peasants, many perks were offered
  - o promised salvation to anyone killed on a crusade
    - would forgive all your sins if you died!
  - o could escape the farm and the lord's control
  - o offered adventure!

- for knights/paladins, this also greatly appealed
  - o all the peasant perks...
  - o could use their fighting skills
  - o chance to gain land and wealth in the East
- for lords, they were concerned with only two things
  - o money and land
- for the Pope, there was great incentive
  - free the Holy Land from the Muslims who didn't believe in Christianity
  - o could help Christians in the East
    - the Byzantine Empire had been fighting the Turks for years, and needed help
    - · would expand his influence

## The Crusades Themselves

- there were more than 5 Crusades in total
- they were mostly all failures
  - the first Crusade caught the Muslims off guard, and the Christians actually took control of the Holy Land
  - the second Crusade was famous
    - o Richard the Lionhearted vs. Saladin
    - o the Christians tried to take Jerusalem, and failed
    - Richard convinced Saladin to allow Christian pilgrims to visit though
  - later Crusades were more land/treasure grabs than anything to deal with Christianity
