Definitions:

1. A psychological disorder characterized by high levels of anxiety that are not specific to any single source.
2. A psychological disorder characterized by unrealistic and excessive fear of a particular class of stimuli.
3. A psychological disorder characterized by the fear of being away from a safe place or safe person.
4. A psychological disorder characterized by recurrent, unwanted thoughts and strong urges to engage in some sort of repetitive ritual-like behavior.
5. A psychological disorder characterized by complaints of wide-ranging ailments for which there are no apparent biological causes.
6. A psychological disorder characterized by the inability to remember important events or vital personal information, such as one's identity.
7. A psychological disorder characterized by the emergence of two or more complete and independently functioning personalities in one person, although only one personality is dominant at any one time.
8. A psychological disorder characterized by persistent and severe feelings of sadness accompanied by changes in appetite, sleep, and behavior patterns.
9. A psychological disorder characterized by alternating states of depression and mania separated by relatively undisturbed periods.
10. A group of psychological disorders characterized by distortions of thought, perception, and emotion as well as bizarre behavior and social withdrawal.
11. A psychological disorder characterized by an exaggerated sense of self-worth and an obsession with fantasies involving personal success.
12. A psychological disorder characterized by a failure to conform to accepted standards of decency, repeated lying and stealing, failure to sustain loving relationships, a low tolerance for boredom, and an absence of guilt and anxiety.
