



In Your Head


- Control center of the body
- Part of the central nervous system with spinal cord
- Covered by the meninges
 - 3 layers
 - Dura mater
 - Arachnoid
 - Pia mater






- Divided into 3 sections
 - Cerebrum
 - Cerebellum
 - Brain Stem
