The business card must include the following:

- *His/her name in large print* /2.5
- *Where he/she could be contacted (not a phone as phone numbers-- did not exist! An address would work best ☺)* /2.5
- *Important accomplishments, skills, knowledge, and or inventions* /5
- *Appropriate illustrations and color* /5
- *Card must be clean, neat, and appealing to all readers!* /5
