## Roman Law and Life

- one of the lasting impacts of the Roman Empire was their legal system, much of which survives today
  - o called Civil Law
- under Civil Law:
  - o people were innocent until proven guilty
  - o laws applied to all regions of the Empire (consistent)
  - o judges based decisions on evidence
  - followed set standards to make sure the accused had fair trials
- we still have all these things today!
- revolutionized the legal system at the time because it used to be quite archaic, inconsistent, and corrupt
- punishments were severe for wrongdoers
- serious criminals were often sent to death in the Coliseum
  usually mauled by wild animals
- lesser crimes were punished fairly in the eyes of Romans
  prison, slavery, fines, etc.
- under Roman rule, slaves and women gained rights
- set the limits of husbands and men as well
- very revolutionary!
