What is a Social Norm?

Social Norm - Shared standards or expectations of **acceptable** behavior by a group or culture.

These norms can be:

1) <u>Unofficial rules</u> - the standard created by the norm does NOT break any legal rules.

2) Official Rules - the norm or expectation of the culture agrees with the legal code. Violating would break the law and the societal expectation.



What is a taboo?

Taboo - a social or religious custom prohibiting or forbidding discussion of a particular practice or forbidding association of a particular person, place, or thing.

Taboos are norms that reflect the society in which they function

Types of Taboos

Social Taboos - An agreed upon action or subject that is deemed to be off limits or frowned upon in society.

Religious Taboos - Agreed upon actions or subject matter that is deemed to be off limits by one's religion. Religious taboos in Catholicism stem from the Bible, Jesus, and the Word of GOD.
