- urbanization is the growth of cities in population and structures people and buildings
- is this a problem?
 - o in 1900, 14% of people lived in cities used to live off the land and farm
 - o now, very few do this
- in "developed" towns, buildings crop up and jobs are usually easy to find
- in "developing" towns, shanties are erected and jobs are few disease, poverty, etc. increased
- "Push factors" things that force people out of an area
 - no jobs/food
 - war
 - disease
 - no entertainment
- "Pull factors" things that attract people to an area
 - chance of employment and prosperity
 - freedom/peace
 - health
 - entertainment
