- An image
- --- Film Name
- Producer/Director (Psychologist/s involved)
- Year in theaters (AKA year of experiment)
- Starring roles=Independent and dependent variables
- A creative #hashtag related to the experiment
- Incorporate 2 vocab terms that relate in 2 Reviews of Movie or taglines
- In addition could include movie "website", spoilers, rating etc
